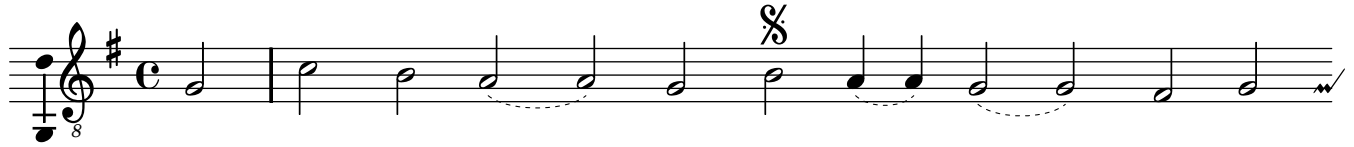


# As I mee walked in a May Morning, Canon in the unison for 4 voices
