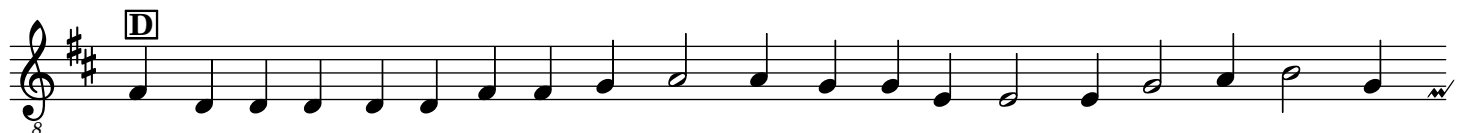
down heave and ho, Rum-be-lo, fol-low me my sweet heart fol-low me where I goe
